TOURNAMENT HOSTS: Dane Pence, Kelly Bartlett, Gary Larsen, and Ben Jenkel (Rules Interpreter)

WHEN: Tuesday, Oct. 1st- 8:30 am Shotgun Start

WHERE: Boise Ranch Golf Course. Buses need to load and unload on the side street and not enter the parking lot at Boise Ranch.

COST: \$20.00 per player. This includes range balls. Please make **checks payable** to Boise Ranch and bring them with you to the tournament.

PRE-TOURNAMENT PRACTICE: Teams that wish to practice before the date of the Girl's Varsity District Championship Tournament should have their coaches/players contact the Boise Ranch Pro Shop (**208-362-6501**) for tee times. You will pay the junior rate of \$10.00 per player if you identify as a high school golfer!

We will be playing the red tees for the Girl's Varsity District Championship

COACHES MEETING: 7:45am on the patio at Boise Ranch - weather permitting. All schools should be represented at the pre-tournament meeting. We will hand out scorecards and go over course rules.

11:00am on the patio at Boise Ranch- weather permitting. Head Coaches Meeting where we will vote on our seasonal awards and discuss this past year together with Athletic Director Rep, Dane Pence.

ATTIRE: Teams will need to dress appropriately for Golf.

NUMBER OF PLAYERS: Each team is allowed 5 Varsity players. The lowest 4 scores will count for the team's score. Please contact us ASAP IF YOU WILL NOT HAVE 5 PLAYERS.

MEALS: No meals provided. There is a snack bar available. Water is available on the course.

RANGE BALLS: Range balls are included as part of the entry fee.

BOISE RANCH GOLF COURSE LOCAL RULES SHEET

The 2024 USGA rules of golf govern all play unless otherwise posted on the Local Rules Sheet and as modified by the IHSAA

Out of bounds defined by white stakes or fence lines and boundary of the golf course

Out of bounds down left side of #3 is out of bounds for hole #3 only (Stroke & Distance)

Ball crossing road is considered out of bounds even if coming to rest in play on a different hole

Sand areas left of #1 fairway, right of #7 fairway and right of #17 green are transition areas and you may ground your club

Free relief from cart paths and cinders around the old yardage marker post areas

Free relief from old path that travels through holes 1, 3, 10, 11, 13, & 18 no closer to the hole

Play all water hazards as "Lateral Hazards"

If you have any doubt to a ruling or procedure, play a second ball (Rule 3-3) and obtain a ruling from the rules committee upon completion of your round and before signing your scorecard

Maximum score on any hole is 10 (Circle 10)

DISTRICT TOURNAMENT RULES

Caddies are not permitted during tournament play

Carts are not permitted, except in case of special medical conditions and permission granted by the IHSAA

Coaches may talk to players between holes (no communication from tee to green). Coaches may offer technical advice and/or instruction only between holes. Penalty for breach of rule is two strokes

All spectators must be a minimum of 25 feet from the competitors at all times. Penalty for continued breach of distance rule is two strokes. There may be aiding of any competitor (sunscreen, water, lost ball) at any time. Penalty for breach of rule is two strokes

Competitors are not permitted to wear headphones or use cell phones / smart watches / GPS devices of any kind during tournament play. Penalty for breach of rule is two strokes. Golfers may use range finders that offer distance only
